Temperature

What is temperature?

Temperature is a measure of the hotness or coldness of something. Can you see the steam rising from the cup? A thermometer is used to measure temperature.

When do we use a thermometer?

When we have a **fever** we use a thermometer to tell our temperature. A high temperature means that we are not well. A thermometer like this is found in the medicine cabinet or first aid box.

We use a thermometer to measure the temperature **outside**. The temperature in Ireland is cooler during the winter than the summer. Ireland has a mild climate. It is neither too hot nor too cold.

There is a thermometer in the **fridge**.

Some food (like ice-cream) must be stored at a low temperature.

Can you think of anywhere else you might find a thermometer?

How do we dress in warm or cold weather?

We wear different clothes depending on the temperature outside. In **winter** we wear a heavy jumper along with a hat and scarf. In **summer** we wear lighter clothes such as t-shirts and shorts. What other types of clothes do we wear in winter and summer?
